

RADAR Quick Message

Many times, users need an expedient way to reach out to patients on the day of their appointment if the staff is running behind or to instruct the patient to meet the technologist in order to protect their privacy in a waiting room. The option to send a RADAR message from the Reception WL or Patient Folder has been added to eRAD RIS.
