#### **Release Announcement**

This release of ERAD RIS 4.2023.005 includes changes related to the display of Provider Portal PACS images.

## FEATURE DETAILS

### Provider Portal

# Service-Only Feature #33425 - Smart loading of portal thumbnail images (Lazy Load)

#### Summary

This performance enhancement to the RIS Portal Viewer ensures that only PACS thumbnail images for visible images are loaded.

#### **Feature Description**

Previously, the RIS PROVIDER PORTAL would load all thumbnails for all series of images when users clicked on the  $\boxed{\text{Images}}$  tab. This unnecessary activity resulted in additional overhead on the PACs server, Portal server, and network.

With this change, thumbnail loading is now "smarter" and will only load 6 thumbnail images for each series that is currently in view. As the user expands a series or scrolls through a series, additional images will load.
