Release Announcement

This release of ERAD RIS 4.2024.051 updates Patient and Referring Portals to add a field to capture Insurance/Attorney information for Workers Comp & Personal Injury insurances.

Feature #34103 – Addition of Insurance/Attorney field for Workers Comp & Personal Injury Insurance Information

Summary

This enhancement to Provider WF Create Order adds a field to capture Insurance/Attorney information for Workers Comp & Personal Injury insurances in both the Patient and Referring Portals.

Background

Previously, if the Workers Comp & Personal Injury was selected as the desired insurance type there was no way to identify the name of the insurance.

Feature Description

With this change, a new **Name of Insurance/Attorney** freeform text field has been added to the Workers Comp & Personal Injury insurance type in both the Referring and Patient Portals.
