

- 1. To begin importing, place the disk to be imported in the CD drive.
- 2. Search eRAD RIS for the patient.
- 3. Right-click on the row and select Import from CD from the floating menu.

- 1. The patient's name should display by default. If it doesn't, click the drop-down to see all patients on the CD.
- 2. Click the drop-down and select Outside CDs. Do not pick any other location.
- 3. Select the procedure description that is closest to what is on the CD.
- 4. The modality should auto-populate after the procedure is chosen.
- 5. Select the correct body part.
- 6. Select the laterality (or bilateral), if applicable.
- 7. Enter any notes to communicate to the Radiologist. Enter the facility, if known, in this space (though that is not required).
- 8. Click the now-active Import button.
