## **Release Announcement**

This release of ERAD RIS 4.2025.014 addresses issues displaying PACS v9 streamed images in Connect Portals.

## Portal Images

## Feature #36307 - Additional Support for PACS SDK Image Streaming

#### Summary

This enhancement to Portal Images provides additional support for PACS SDK Imaging streaming, ensuring continued functionality when failures occur.

#### Background

Previously, the SDK Image streaming would become unresponsive when an error was encountered, with no fallback method to recover the session.

With these changes, the Portals will be more aggressive in monitoring PACS failures, providing a method to recover and fall back to the traditional process of image loading.

### Feature Description

These changes are supportive of existing functionality tied to the app configuration, EnableWebViewer and the streaming server for PACS v9.

#### Fall Back Method

When the streaming server encounters an error or becomes unresponsive, the image loading process will fall back to the traditional method, directly calling the PACS server to load the images in a JPEG format.

#### **Displaying an Error Message**

When configured, an error message will be displayed when the streaming server encounters an error or becomes unresponsive.

### Service Team Upgrade Instructions

No Service Team actions are necessary to deploy this feature; however, optional configuration is available:

#### Portals

#### Changes to applicationsettings.config

- Optionally, set EPWWebAppErrorImageLoading for desired Portal(s)
- Default: Image
  - When set to Image, the image loading will revert to the existing functionality and the load the images in JPEG formatting if an error should occur.
  - When set to Error, the images will not load, and the user will see the configured error message based on the new paragraph config settings.

### **Configuration Instructions**

No System Administrator actions are necessary to enable this feature; however, optional configuration is available.
